(73) The **Walcott Inlet (Lat:16 24 S Long:124 40 E)** is truly spectacular and by air is only some 150 kilometres from Derby. The remarkably narrow Yule Entrance allows boat access to the major inlet that extends up to 30 kilometres from Collier Bay in the west to the mouths of the Calder and Charnley Rivers in the east.

In places the inlet is in excess of 11 kilometres in width and there are extensive tidal mudflats that can be exposed up to five kilometres on the bottom of the large spring tides. On either side of the inlet are strikingly different landforms resulting from the incredible age of the topography.

To the north and north-east of the inlet there are the low undulating lands that are typical of volcanic country whilst on
